Reminders!

- Please label your children's clothes and belongings – it is hard for us to locate missing items without knowing who it belongs to
- Do not send your child into nursery with food/drink in their hands or bags – we have children with allergies in the nursery – we provide all the food/drink that your child needs whilst at nursery
